There was a good crowd there to see Darryl Vallis demonstrating how a piece of rough lumber is converted into a bunch of ¼-round moldings. Oh to have his machinery in our home shops. An important sidelight to the meeting was that Darryl told us that they do mill custom molding profiles and from what I can see, they are far and wide less expensive than the competition.

Also interesting was the inventory expansion, HSH has gone from a stock of 16 species to well over 40 and add to that a large inventory of exotic plywoods. The Baltic Birch that they have on hand is a very impressive 11 ply, ¾" thick. Certainly a stable material for drawer or jig making. The material seems to be void-free so it can be used for kitchen cabinets as well.

## THUE BUT

A thought crossed my mind the other day and I thought that I would pass it on to you. As all of you know by now, the Halifax Atlantic Woodshow has been cancelled this year. The show will be in Moncton however and many of us really want to see it. I have contacted Budget Rent-A-Car (Van) and here is the deal. A 7-passenger van for a day trip will cost \$63 + tax for a day. This includes 200 free km's + \$0.15 per km over that. So, here is the math.

Cost of the van - \$72.00, 700 km's (500 @ 0.15) = \$75.00 plus of course, the unknown cost of the gas. Let's figure gas at \$100. And we have a total of \$247.00, divide that by 7 and we have a total of \$35.29 per person. I have talked to the show people and they will provide us with 7 free passes for the show so there will be no cost there and we can share the driving. Anyone interested?
