Important Activities Early in the New Year

As announced to all at out October Meeting we will be moving the location of our regular meetings and the AWA library to the Salvation Army Church, on Pleasant Street in Dartmouth.

As much as our current meeting location at Kent has been favourable, we have had a long standing goal to find a permanent meeting place that provides "accessibility".

The first meeting in the Salvation Army Church will take place for our meeting in February. (Our January meeting will be Halifax Specialty Hardwood). We already have keys and have been instructed on how to access and secure the Salvation Army Church when we want to.

Between now and February, we need to re-locate our library. Tied to that activity is a plan to tidy up the contents of the library, as it is becoming quite stuffed with some older and perhaps outdated material. We hope to undertake this job on a Saturday early in January. This event will be separate from the actual move of the library.

As part of the transition we've also decided to build new cabinets for the library at the Salvation Army Church. We want the new cabinets in place before moving the library contents from Kent.

Some basic preliminary design planning has told us we want two cabinets, and we want them on wheels.

I'm asking you to consider how you might participate in or even lead any of these transition events (library cleanup, construction of new cabinets, and the library move), and let me know if you will by email. Soon after the holiday period we'll firm up dates for each event.
