IRONWOOD BOWLS

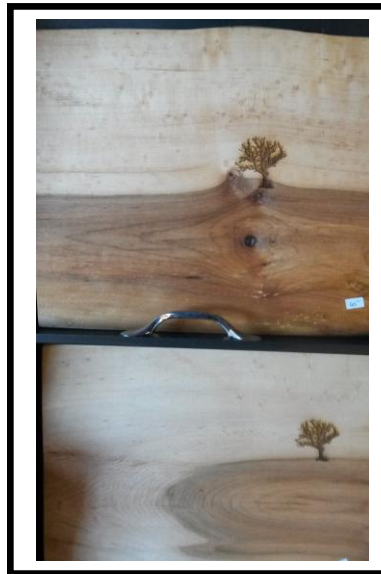
Created with a unique cutting method from the 1800's, that ensures no wood is wasted. Each piece is sanded and polished by hand.

'Families' of bowls are cut from a single block of wood, producing a set of four with matching grain.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS
*Do not soak in water.
*Wipe with damp cloth and dry immediately.
*Apply mineral oil occasionally to preserve the moisture content of the wood.
