Brad was our presenter at our February meeting. He gave a detailed presentation on the making of chop sticks. He starts with a ¼ in blanks. He showed a series of jigs uses for tapering and shaping them into perfection. In the picture you see a jig by his small plan. This jig is to put a pyramid on the larger end of each chop stick. Brad says making chop sticks is labour intensive. By joining two different woods make them bit more decorative. He also talked about how other people have chosen to decorate ones they made. Brad gave some members a chance to try their luck at shaping one of the sticks.
